General Needs Loan Hebrew Free Loan Society (HFLS)

Interest-free loans of up to \$7500 to cover emergencies, large expenses, and general needs of all kinds. No credit checks and no fees charged.

Note: HFLS offers more interest-free loans in larger amounts for different needs, such as small businesses, storm damage, health care, education, and fertility/adoption.



Eligibility:

- · Resident of NYC, Westchester, or Long Island
- Low or moderate income: check here
- Employed friend or family member as guarantor
